

# STYSA PERPETUAL CALENDAR

## 2008 - 2009 SEASONAL YEAR

This calendar may be changed by majority vote of the STYSA Executive Committee.

**Note:** Deadlines indicated here are state deadlines - STYSA Member Associations will have earlier deadlines in order to comply with the state deadline. Be sure to check with the appropriate person within your Member Association for local deadlines. Any deadline that falls on a Saturday or Sunday will be automatically extended to the following Monday.

<b>AUGUST 2008</b>	
1	<b>STYSA Registration Period begins</b> - Players may be officially rostered to teams for the Fall 2008 season play as of this date. The movement of players between primary teams after this date must be processed as transfers.
<b>SEPTEMBER 2008</b>	
1	<b>US Youth Soccer / STYSA seasonal year begins</b>
<b>OCTOBER 2008</b>	
1	<b>Initial Registration Deadline</b> - Fall Season Registration is due at the State Office, postmarked* no later than October 1. With the implementation of the Affinity online registration program, there is no longer a need for Member Associations to submit registration information on players or coaches as it's visible to the State Office at the time of entry. Association Registrars need to print a Player Summary Report, calculate the fees due to the State, and forward the report to the State Office along with a check for the appropriate fees based on the number of players.  *Postmark is defined as the date placed by the US Postal Service or other delivery company and not the date from a private, postal machine.
10	<b>Fall Championship Team Counts</b> - All Member Associations interested in sending Division II and Division III teams to Fall Championship District Games must provide the number of eligible teams in each age group and competition level for consideration in the allocation of teams.
15	<b>District Allocations</b> - District Vice Presidents will prepare allocations for Fall Championship District competitions and distribute to Member Association Presidents.
<b>NOVEMBER 2008</b>	
1	<b>Final Registration Deadline</b> - Fall Season Registration is due at the State Office, postmarked* no later than November 1. With the implementation of the Affinity online registration program, there is no longer a need for Member Associations to submit registration information on players or coaches as it's visible to the State Office at the time of entry. Association Registrars need to print a Player Summary Report, calculate the fees due to the State, deduct any fees paid at the October 1 Initial Registration deadline and forward to the State Office the report and the balance of fees due.  *Postmark is defined as the date placed by the US Postal Service or other delivery company and not the date from a private, postal machine.

1	<b>Confirmation of Participation</b> - Each Member Association must confirm in writing to the State Office the number of teams per age group and competition level the association will send to Fall Championships. For competitions based on allocations, the Association must confirm whether they will fill all allocated slots or, if not, which slots they are unable to fill.
5	<b>Fall Championship Team Fees</b> - State Office will invoice Member Associations for teams advancing to Fall Championship District Tournaments. Member Associations will be invoiced based on allocations for Division II and III. District will be invoiced for Super II teams.
18	<b>Fall Championship Team Fee Payment Deadline</b> - Payment is due from all Member Associations / Districts who were invoiced for teams advancing to Fall Championship District and/or State Tournaments. Unless notification has been provided to the State Office or appropriate District Vice President that a team is not available to fill an allocated slot, payment of the invoice is due in full by this date.
30	<b>Monday before District Tournament Play</b> - Team information is due in the State Office for all teams advancing to Fall Championship District Tournaments in Division II and Division III. In the event there are two or more Super II groups requiring District Games, information is also due for those teams. Information to be provided included: team name, team number, coach's name, coach's email address, team seeding and penalty points.
<b>DECEMBER 2008</b>	
1	<b>Soccer Start Registration</b> for players and coaches is due in the State Office. With the implementation of the Affinity online registration program, there is no need for the Association Registrar to submit player or coach registration information as it is visible to the state upon entry into the online registration program. Association Registrars must submit the registration fees for all players identified as Soccer Start along with confirmation of which players have been identified as Soccer Start eligible.
6 - 7	<b>1st Weekend in December</b> - Fall Championship District Tournaments for Division II, Division III, and Super II (if needed) boys and girls teams in Under-11 through Under-18/19
8	<b>Monday before State Tournament Play</b> - Team information is due in the State Office for all teams advancing to Fall Championship State Tournaments in Division II and Super II. Information to be provided included: team name, team number, coach's name, coach's email address, team seeding and penalty points.
13 - 14	<b>2nd Weekend in December</b> - Rainout date for Fall Championship District Tournaments
13 - 14	<b>2nd Weekend in December</b> - State Tournaments for Super II Under-13 through Under-18/19 and Division II Under-11 through Under-18/19
20 - 21	<b>3rd Weekend in December</b> - Rainout date for Fall Championship State Tournaments

1	<b>Beginning of UIL (High School) Soccer Season</b>
31	<b>Soccer Start Program History</b> must be filed with the State Office by all approved teams.

1	<b>Spring Cup Deadlines</b> - Entry deadlines for teams interested in participating in Spring 2009 US Youth Soccer National Championships, President's Cup, and Director's Cup competitions
6 - 8	<b>STYSA Winter Governing Board Meeting</b> - Omni Hotel, Corpus Christi <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>♦ Bids are due for the 2010 Winter Governing Board Meeting</li> <li>♦ Election of Officers</li> </ul>

5 - 7	<b>US Youth Soccer Workshop / Coaches Convention</b> - San Jose, California
22	<b>Final Roster Deadline for Western District U15 through U19 teams entered in the US Youth Soccer National Championship Series, President's Cup, or Director's Cup</b> - All roster changes must be completed in the Affinity system and signed copies of all transfer and release forms mailed to the STYSA State Office prior to this date.
22	<b>Final Roster Deadline for Eastern District U11 through U18 teams entered in the US Youth Soccer National Championship Series, President's Cup, or Director's Cup</b> - All roster changes must be completed in the Affinity system and signed copies of all transfer and release forms mailed to the STYSA State Office prior to this date.
<b>APRIL 2009</b>	
6	<b>South Texas Cup Team Count Deadline</b> - Member Associations having teams interested in participating in South Texas Cup must provide to the State Office the number of teams per age group in order that allocation of teams can be prepared by the District Vice President
9 - 11	<b>UIL High School State Tournament</b>
15	<b>Spring Registration Deadline</b> - Fees for all new players registered for the Spring 2009 season are due in the State Office by this date. Fees for Spring are only paid for players who have not been registered with any Member Association or Club during the current Seasonal Year.
<b>MAY 2009</b>	
1	<b>Soccer Start Spring Registration Deadline</b> - All registration information and fees for new players registered for the Spring season in approved Soccer Start programs are due in the State Office by this deadline.
11	<b>South Texas Cup Team Information and Fees Deadline</b> - Each Member Association sending teams to the South Texas Cup District Games must provide to the State Office a copy of the approved roster for each advancing team and the team entry fee. Entry fee information will be posted on the STYSA website with detailed information about the competition prior to the start of the Spring season.
