Rule as it presently reads:

3.3.1. **TEAM ROSTER.** No team, Under-13 through Under-16, shall be allowed more than eighteen (18) players nor less than seven (7) registered players at any given time. **(Changed 2.8.09)**
No team, Under-17 through Under-19, shall be allowed more than twenty-two (22) players nor less than seven (7) registered players at any given time. The maximum number of players in uniform and eligible to play at any one game shall be eighteen (18). **(Changed 2.8.09)**

Proposed Additions and/or Changes:

3.3.1. **TEAM ROSTER.**
No team, Under-13 through Under-16, shall be allowed more than eighteen (18) players nor less than seven (7) registered players at any given time. **(Changed 2.8.09)**
No team, Under-17 through Under-19, shall be allowed more than twenty-two (22) players nor less than seven (7) registered players at any given time. The maximum number of players in uniform and eligible to play at any one game shall be eighteen (18). **(Changed 2.8.09)**

A roster may have up to three (3) players that are rostered via a club player pass system. The maximum number of players in uniform and eligible to play shall not exceed eighteen (18) players at any given time.

SECTION II - JUSTIFICATION FOR THE PROPOSED RULE CHANGE:

The Club Player Pass concept 's main objective is to allow coaches to move players freely within their own club, based on player development needs and specific team needs. This concept is very similar to how the U11 and U 12 age groups are currently managed.

This addition to the team roster section allows the player passes in Uner-13 through Under-19.
