Rule as it presently reads:

5.4.b. Player ID Cards

- (2) **Division I, Super II and II players.** To play, a Division I, Super II or Division II player's ID card must be properly prepared, laminated and contain the proper information, including the player's name and birth date, a recent photo of the player, the player's STYSA ID number and the STYSA team code and is signed (stamped) by the Local or Member Association Registrar.

Proposed Additions and/or Changes:

5.4.b. Player ID Cards

- (2) **Division I, Qualifying, Super II and Division II players.** To play, a Division I, Qualifying, Super II or Division II player's ID card must be properly prepared, laminated and contain the proper information, including the player's name and birth date, a recent photo of the player, the player's STYSA ID number and the STYSA team code and is signed (stamped) by the Local or Member Association Registrar.

SECTION II - JUSTIFICATION FOR THE PROPOSED RULE CHANGE:

With the addition of a Qualifying level of play in some areas of the state, it is necessary to add the competition level to the requirements for playoffs. Although this level of play does not currently participate in Fall Championships, there is a strong probability that teams from this play level will participate in Spring Cup play.
