STYSA Policy on Under-10 Teams Playing Rules

On March 11, 2001, the STYSA Executive Committee adopted the following policy, effective immediately:

"Players eligible to participate on newly-formed Under-11 teams may begin practicing and participating in tryouts, tournaments, scrimmages and friendly games on May 1 or the day after the end of each Associations' spring season, which ever is later."

The word "tryouts" has been added to the previous policy statement passed in 1998.

Alcoholic and Tobacco Product Policy

It is the policy of South Texas Youth Soccer Association (STYSA) that no alcohol be sold at or brought to STYSA sanctioned leagues games or tournaments. It is the responsibility of the organizers of STYSA events to ensure that this policy is strictly adhered to.

Adopted by the STYSA Executive Committee, December 18th, 2000.

South Texas Youth Soccer Association (STYSA) prohibits solicitation and/or sponsorship by distributors or manufacturers of alcoholic beverages or tobacco products. This includes imprinting the brand names of tobacco products or alcoholic beverages on any player's equipment and/or uniforms.
